

Our summer uniform:

for boys is:-

- Grey trousers/shorts
- pale blue polo shirts
- Royal blue pullover with an embroidered school emblem
- Grey socks
- Tie
- Black sensible footwear (not trainers or boots)

for girls is:-

- Blue and white gingham dress or pale blue polo shirts may be worn with grey skirts/trousers.
- white socks
- Royal blue pullover / cardigan with an embroidered school emblem
- Black sensible footwear (not trainers or boots)

Hair

- Hair should be tied back with a plain hair band in either blue, white or black only. Children are permitted to wear a thin plain head band in either blue, white or black only.
- No other hair accessories are permitted.

School Session Consultation

Today you will have received, via your child, a paper letter and also received a notification of the same letter via the school APP. These notifications relate to the government pledge that every school will be open for a minimum of 32.5 hrs per week by September 2023. This change in legal requirement directly affects St Bernadette's, as our current working week falls one hour and 15 minutes short of the required time.

Therefore, the Governing Body have written to you to open a period of consultation on the options available to us in amending school operating hours at St Bernadette's. It is our intention that the new operating hours will be in place for September 2022.

The governing body are seeking to gather your views on two options for amending school session times, as detailed below: both options allow St Bernadette's to meet the new legal requirement from the Government.

There is no option to maintain the current school sessions times as this is simply not possible.

As part of the consultation we ask that you complete the questionnaire available on our school App and submit any questions you may have via the same platform. There is also an option to request an 'in person meeting' to discuss the proposed changes. If there are sufficient requests, a parent/carer consultation meeting will be offered in the week beginning 16th of May.

Our consultation period will close on Monday 23rd May.

Parents and carers will be notified of the Governing Body decision on Friday 27th May. This will give all families three months' notice of the change so that you are able to sort logistical issues regarding the start and end of the school day. Thank you for your understanding, cooperation and participation in this very important matter.
