#### **PE Uniform**

As you know, we have been trialling our 'Ready to go!' PE uniform. On balance, taking into consideration the views of the children, teacher and parents and reflecting on the teaching and learning time saved across the curriculum we will be keeping the 'ready to go' approach. Children will now be required to wear their PE kits on their PE days. Our PE kit consists of: yellow badged polo shirt; navy shorts; royal blue joggers and a badged royal blue hoody. Plimsolls and/or trainers.

#### Our PE Kit

- PE Polo shirt with school badge
- Navy Shorts
- Royal blue jogging bottoms
- Royal blue school hoodie with school badge.
- Trainers/plimsolls

Please note: - non-badged tops either hoodies or polo shirts are **not** permitted and children are **not** allowed to wear football kits or any other sports or alternative clothing for PE other than the school PE uniform. Our School uniform is very important to us as a school family, it brings us together as a school family, ensures that we are all equal and it is very smart – our PE kit is no exception.

# **Swimming**

We have been busy behind the scenes reorganising our swimming programme. Going forward our children will begin their swimming journey in Year 3 (Beech class). Year 4 (Eucalyptus class) will undertake their life saving skills programme. This change has been made in response to evidence that children have a greater aptitude to learn to swim in the younger year group. It is also in response to the impact Covid has had on our children.

As we begin to embed this new system, we will also be meeting the needs of our non-swimmers in Years 5 & 6. These children will continue to attend swimming and I have attached a table which shows which classes will go swimming and when. Our PE timetable has been organised so that children who can swim the required distance will have PE on the same day so that learning time is not compromised.

You will receive a letter at the start of the summer term informing you if your child will be going swimming.


