## **Healthy School**

At St Bernadette's we recognise the important part a healthy diet plays in a child's well-being and their ability to learn and achieve effectively. We believe that as a school, in partnership with parents and carers, we can make a major contribution to improving children's health by increasing their knowledge and understanding of food and helping them to make healthy food choices.

We have noticed that some of our children are bringing unsuitable snacks for mid-morning break. A piece of fruit is sufficient at break time. Sweets, crisps and biscuits are not supportive of our policy and therefore not permitted.

#### Uniform

We have been very impressed with how smart the children have looked on their return. Our Year 5 pupils looked super smart as they did a wonderful job of showing prospective families around our school.

I would however, like to take this opportunity to share some reminders about our uniform rules:-

- \* Children are not permitted to wear large bows and accessories in their hair. Small clips which keep the hair off the face are acceptable.
- \* Long hair should be tied up out of the face.
- \* Jewellery, with the exception of watches is **not** permitted in school. This rule is due to health and safety rules. If your child has had their ears pierced within the last 6 weeks, we ask that you come into school to sign a health and safety waiver form. This is **NOT** a parent consent form to wear earrings. In all other cases we ask that all earrings are removed over the weekend.
- \* Blue Polo shirts are part of our **summer** uniform all children should now be wearing their shirt and tie. **PE Uniform** 
  - \* PE polo shirts must have the school badge on them. All children as the weather gets colder should be wearing royal blue jogging bottoms. Leggings are not permitted.

There is a pre-loved uniform sale for all badged items on the last Friday of every month. Thank you to the Friends of St Bernadette for organising this and especially to Vickie for all the washing and ironing! As ever, if you need support with school uniform, please come and speak to us in the office.

## Nasal Flu Immunisations

The School Vaccination Team will be in school on Wednesday 20th October to administer the annual flu immunisation for **ALL** classes. You will receive have received an email in the next few weeks with a link for you to offer your consent. The school nursing team arrange all aspects of the immunisation programme with parents and carers directly. School, in particular Mrs. Maudsley, do not co-ordinate consent any longer.

## **Data Collection Sheets**

In the next few weeks we are sending home your child's data sheet showing all the information we hold on the school computer database and would be grateful if you could please check all the details, sign and return to the school office as soon as possible. Please check for allergies and food preferences and update this as necessary. It is vital that we have this information in school.
