### What I should know-

Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.



### Key Knowledge

- Plants may grow from either seeds or bulbs. These then germinate and grow into seedlings which then continue to **grow** into mature plants.
- These mature plants may have flowers which then develop into seeds, berries, fruits etc.
- Seeds and bulbs need to be planted outside at particular times of year and they will germinate and grow at different rates.
- Some plants are better suited to growing in full **sun** and some grow better in partial or full **shade**. Plants also need different amounts of **water** and space to grow well and stay **healthy**.

### Key Vocabulary

**Light**-Something that makes things visible.

**Shade**- Darkness and coolness caused by shelter from the sun.

**Sun**- The star round which the Earth orbits.

**Warm**- A high temperature.

**Cool**- A colder temperature.

**Water**- A transparent liquid which we can drink.

**Grow**- To get bigger or taller.

**Healthy**- In good condition.
