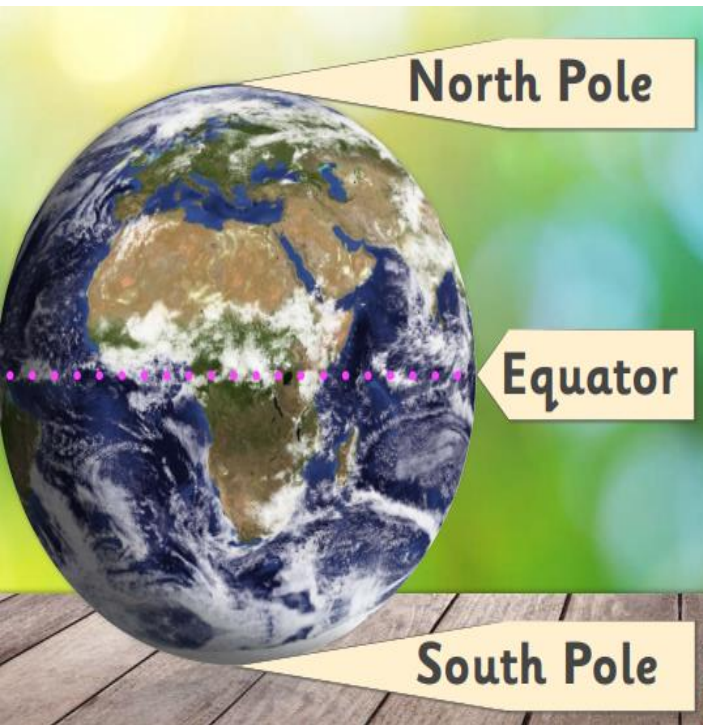




What I should know-

Key Knowledge

- The daily weather is different to the seasonal weather.
- Inland areas usually have less sunshine and wind, and more rain. They're often a bit colder, too.
- Coastal areas usually get less rain, but more sunshine and wind. They're often a bit warmer, too.
- The equator goes around the middle of the Earth, where it is widest. Countries near the equator have hot weather all year round.
- Countries near the North and South poles have cold weather all year round.

Key Vocabulary

- **Equator-** An imaginary circle around the Earth.
- **Seasonal weather-** weather during each of the seasons.
- **Daily weather-** weather of any particular day
- **Overcast-** Lots of grey, dull clouds in the sky.
- **Sleet-** A mixture of rain and snow.
- **North & South Poles-** The North Pole is at the top of the world. The South Pole is at the bottom of the world
