#### **Timeline**

**1200 BC** The Trojan War begins (Athens versus Troy)

**1100 BC** End of Mycenaean age, Ancient Greece enters a 'Dark Age'.

**800 BC** The Ancient Greeks found colonies around the Mediterranean and the Black Sea.

776 BC The first Olympic Games.

**700 BC** The liad and Odyssey set down by Homer.

**508 BC** Democracy is founded in Athens.

**431 BC** The Peloponnesian War (Athens versus Sparta) begins.

**404 BC** The Peloponnesian War ends with the defeat of Athens by Sparta and with it comes to an end of Greece's 'Golden Age'.

**336 BC** Alexander the Great ruler of Ancient Greece and establishes an Ancient Greek Empire.

146 BC Rome conquers Greece

### **Key Knowledge**

- Ancient Greece was made up of city states.
   There were often battles between these states.
   Important city states of ancient Greece included Athens, Corinth and Sparta.
- Ancient Greece is significant historically because many things in culture today, especially in modern Europe, have been influenced by the idea of the ancient Greek civilisation.
- The first Olympic Games happened in ancient Greece, in Olympia.
- Independent city states existed for most of the ancient Greek period. However, near the end of this period, King Philip II of Macedonia ruled over all of ancient Greece.
- Alexander the Great (The son of King Philip) took over the empire along with other lands that he conquered.



## **Key Vocabulary**

Ancient- Something from a long time ago.

Civilisation- A human society with well-developed rules and government, often where technology and the arts are considered important.

City States- Small areas that ancient Greece was divided into, each with their own government, laws and army.

Democracy- A system where the citizens of a country or state are involved in the way it is run.

Empire- A group of countries or states that is ruled over by one ruler or country.

Legacies- Things that live on after someone dies or after a civilisation or event ends.
