Homework

As you are aware, the reading ability of a student has a massive impact on how well they can access the whole curriculum. To this end, St Bernadette's places a huge value on reading and has a number of initiatives and interventions in place to help improve the reading ages of all our young people.

To help our drive to improve reading ages further and faster we are requesting your help by making sure your child is reading at home and that an adult listens to them whenever you can. Pupils benefit greatly from reading to an adult for just 20 minutes each day.

Topic Knowledge Organisers to learn for class Quiz	Daily Daily Friday Spelling Test Monday for Monday As appropriate
