Key Vocabulary

monarch A monarch is a king or queen, an emperor or a sultan.

Parliament This is where politicians meet to decide laws.

succession This is the order in which a monarch's family will take over the throne. crown Crowns are usually made of metal and are worn on the heads of kings and queens.

power Something kings and queens have to make people do what they say.
