What I should know- I know that the Romans launched a successful invasion in 43 AD and left in 410 AD because Rome was under attack. I know that Boudicca was the tribal leader of the Iceni who led a failed uprising against the Romans. I know that Roman Society was ordered: Emperor, Patricians (aristocracy), Plebeians and Slaves. I know that the Celts were tribal people from Europe and the Iron age ran alongside Celtic Britain.

#### **Timeline**

410 AD The Romans withdraw from Britain During the 5th and 7th Century AD, Scotland was invaded by Gaels, who originated from Ireland.

449 AD - The Anglo-Saxons arrive in Britain from mainland Europe.

516 AD - Local Britons defeat the Angles and Saxon invaders.

680 AD - The mighty epic poem 'Beowulf' is thought to have been written around this time.

757 AD - King Offa of Mercia builds a huge wall along the border of Wales and Mercia. 871 AD Alfred the Great becomes king of Wessex.

886 AD King Alfred agrees a treaty. Alfred keep the west and the Vikings the east which is later known as Danelaw.
